

# Youth Steps Against Power Abuse

**On the 6th to 10th of September 2020, a representative of Permacultura Cantabria attended to a Training Course as part of the Erasmus+ project: Youth Steps Against Power Abuse** (AGREEMENT N°: 2019-1-PL01-KA205-062772).

This Participative Visit was hosted by AENIE in Évora, Portugal and attended by participants from 4 of the partner entities. The main objective of the Visit was to address 'Cyberbullying' among young people.

Firstly, the participants visited a school in Torrão to learn best practices against cyberbullying in a conflictive school. Back to Évora, in the afternoon, AENIE presented the dissemination tool awarded best practices in 2017 and, after that, participants introduced their respective organizations and presented effective strategies for preventing cyberbullying in their countries.

On the second day, they visited Santa Maria school in Beja, where the Police delivered a talk about measures against cyberbullying in the school environment. In the afternoon, a member of the city council visited us in Beja school to talk about social projects done in the city related to bullying and cyberbullying.

On the third day, participants visited Teckies in Startup Sintra for a workshops through which the participants could improve their knowledge on what behaviours are considered cyberbullying, what are the warning signs, what does the legislation say about this type of violence and improve their skills and tools to prevent or act in these situations.

Besides that, they could spend time together sharing experiences, exchanging best practices, visiting the cities and enjoying local food.
